

Silicone VS Saline

Saline

Saline implants are less expensive than silicone ones and are FDA-approved for cosmetic use in women 18 and older. Since the implants are inserted empty and filled after placement, women who opt for saline implants typically have smaller scars. Filling after placement also allows for more precisely symmetrical results, particularly in women with significant asymmetry prior to surgery.

Silicone

Silicone gel implants are FDA-approved for cosmetic use in women 22 and older and are currently the more popular choice for breast augmentation among breast augmentation patients in Charlotte. Filled with a thick silicone gel that has a jelly-like texture, silicone implants won't wrinkle, and the contents are designed to stay in place even in the unlikely event of a breach in the outer implant shell.ere's one that might better meet your goals for breast augmentation surgery in Charlotte.

Bra size vs Augmentation size


Determining the appropriate breast implant size is crucial, taking into account your bra size. Bra manufacturers utilize cup sizes, while professionals in breast augmentation work with cubic centiliters (cc).

- Smaller implants: Breast implants usually start around 125cc.
- Smaller implants can significantly decrease the likelihood of experiencing breast-related issues such as back or neck pain.
- Most common: The most frequently used range for breast implants falls between 300cc and 500cc.
- For women seeking a fuller shape, implants ranging from 300cc to 360cc are generally sufficient.


Understanding Implant Profiles

Implant profile is a measure how far the implant projects forward in relation to its base width, (think the part that sits on the chest wall). You'll see it expressed in terms like low, moderate, moderate plus, and high. But it's not a choice you can make independent of other options.


- · Low Profile

The right profile for you will depend on your chest width and existing breast "footprint" as well as your desired size increase.









Average cost of Breast Implants

Costs of breast implant surgery are widely varied throughout the nation. There are three basic components of most surgical quotes: the surgeon's fee, the anesthesia fee, and the facility (operating room fee). In breast implant procedures, the cost of the implant must be factored in as well. The surgeon's fee varies with the surgeon's level of experience, the extent of his or her training, as well as the location of the practice. Geography and the quality of the surgical facility are likely the most significant factors in determining the operating room and anesthesia fees.





As per data from the American Society of Plastic Surgeons, the mean expense for breast augmentation surgery (augmentation mammaplasty) is reported to be \$3,947, reflecting statistics from the year 2019.

This figure represents the fundamental cost for typical breast implant expenditures nationwide. It's important to note that this figure excludes expenses associated with anesthesia, operating room facilities, and other related charges. In simpler terms, the average costs related to breast implants can potentially surge much higher, ranging between \$5,000 and \$10,000.

The Procedure Breast augmentation is an outpatient procedure, typically performed in our onsite AAAASF fully accredited surgical suite. Your entire surgery experience will take several hours, including time to relax before your procedure, about 1 hour for the surgery itself, and 30–40 minutes of post-procedure recovery.

Recovery Process

After your procedure, you will likely sleep for a few hours at home and then have a light meal. Some women will be pain-free and drive themselves to the office the next day, others with more muscle work may have more soreness or pressure-type discomfort for 3-5 days. We have a complete pain management program in place to ensure a more comfortable recovery process.


Personalized Recovery Program

Dr. Ditesheim will provide you with a prescription for pain medication to ease any discomfort following surgery. He encourages early movement and activity as soon as possible, beginning the next day. Easy exercise can be resumed by the second week. Sex is usually limited based on the level of discomfort, although each person is different. High-impact sports like waterskiing should be avoided for the first 6 weeks.
